## The Competition

The theme of the 2022 competition is **Resilience**. Psychologists define resilience as the process of adapting well in the face of adversity, trauma, tragedy, threats, or significant sources of stress.

Participating in the competition will help refine your PM knowledge, develop your portfolio and give you a chance to win cash prizes! Teams must describe how their team or project demonstrated resilience through the process. Put your learning to practise and register your team!

Projects will be judged by a panel of certified Project Management Professionals on how well the team is able to incorporate Project Management principles, skills and execution. Each team must present the defined scope of their project, schedule, budget, stakeholders, and risks, as referenced in the PMBOK®.

## Rules of Engagement

1. Teams should have a minimum of three members
2. All participants must be enrolled at a post-secondary institution
3. Projects must be completed between September 2021 and March 2022

## Things to Consider

1. It is recommended that one individual on the team has experience in Project Management, is enrolled in a PM Program or has taken a PM course
2. The project should examine all knowledge areas: Integration, Scope, Scheduling, Cost, Quality, Resource Communications, Procurement, and Stakeholder Management
3. It is encouraged that you have a well-rounded team
